Blogger's Last Name, First Initial. Middle Initial. (Blog post date). Title of blog. Blog Name. URL

(Citation Maker accounts for the fact that blogs and other online platforms that publish articles continuously should follow the citation format of a periodical article.)

Blog post comment

- Commenter's Last Name, First Initial. Middle Initial or Username. (Blog comment date). Title of blog comment or up to first 20 words of comment exactly as written [Comment on the blog post "Blog post title"]. *Blog Name*. URL

(Since the commenter did not indicate his or her full or real name, only their username is listed in the Author field.)
