

Audio Podcast & Radio Program Citation Examples for APA 7th Ed.

All entries on a References page should be double-spaced. To save room, our examples have not been double-spaced.

Audio podcast recording, series, online

- Fogarty, M. (Host). (2006-present). *Grammar Girl quick and dirty tips for better writing* [Audio podcast]. Macmillan. https://www.quickanddirtytips.com/grammar-girl
- Host's Last Name, First Initial. Middle Initial. (Host). (Year-Year). *Title of podcast* [Audio podcast]. Production Company. URL

(If the series is still airing, replace the second year with the word "present." As of the creation of this document, *Grammar Girl* is still airing.)

NOTE: When you listen to this podcast, the host introduces herself this way, "Grammar Girl, here. I'm Mignon Fogarty." If you want to include the host's username in the citation, only enter the host's real name in Citation Maker. After you save the citation to your reference list, add the username in square brackets before "(Host)." The updated citation would look like this:

Audio podcast transcript, episode, no known episode number, online

(If you primarily used the text of the podcast episode, which is called a transcript, indicate that in the bracketed description field in the citation. Citation Maker does that automatically when you choose the Transcript on a Podcast option.)

Audio podcast recording, episode, with episode number, on an app

(APA instructs that if a podcast is accessed via an app, omit the URL.)

Radio program recording, episode, online

- Host's Last Name, First Initial. Middle Initial. (Host). (Date radio program episode aired). Title of radio program episode (No. #, if available) [Radio broadcast]. In *Title of radio program series*. Production Company. URL

(When a radio program is recorded, sometimes producers label the recording as a podcast. In that case, it is acceptable to identify the recording as either a podcast or a radio program in your citation.)
